UPSSSC VDO Selection for UPSSSC Gram Vikas Adhikari & Samaj Kalyan Paryvakshak, Gram Panchayat Adhikari (Village Development Officer) Post will be according to the written examination.

Written Test comprises of Following Points :-

- Written Test will be consisting of 150 objective type questions. Every question will carry 2 marks.
- Time Duration for Written Test is 120 Minutes (2 Hours). There can be No Interview in Exam.
- There will be 0.50 Negative Marking in UP VDO Exam 2018.
